Dear Newman School Families,

I hope you are enjoying a relaxing and meaningful summer filled with adventure, wonder, and time with family and friends. The beginning of the new school year is just around the corner and we look forward to welcoming your children to school and working together with you to challenge their minds, engage their imaginations, and touch their souls.

BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHT AND ICE CREAM SOCIAL will take place on **Wednesday, August 21st, from 6 - 7:00 p.m.** Our teachers are looking forward to welcoming returning students and meeting their new students and families.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL: School begins on Monday, August 26th. Children will begin their day in the classroom at 8:30, while parents will go to the library for a brief get-together. Teachers will be working in the building on August 19, 20, and 21. If you want to come to the school for a brief visit before the school year begins, please let me know and we can arrange a time to visit when teachers are in their rooms on that Tuesday or Wednesday.

SCHOOL HOURS: Our school day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m.

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE is available. See the enclosed form for more information.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES: We will buy most of the necessary school supplies for you, and ask that you please send in a check for \$30 to cover those. Payment can be made by check or by credit card online. Go to ttsp.org, click on "About Us" and select "Make a Payment." Please see the enclosed list for all other items that your child needs to bring to school on the first day.

KIPPOT: Out of respect for everyone's individual choice regarding wearing kippot, we ask families who wish for their child to wear a kippah to please provide the kippah (and a clip).

SNACK: Families will provide their own snacks. Please pack an extra piece of fruit, cereal, cheese and vegetables, an extra sandwich, or other nutritious food for your child's daily snack.

LUNCH: Lunch time is 11:00 a.m. for the Early Childhood (Gan Katan) class with our Kindergarten (Gan) through grade 3 students eating at noon. Children need to bring dairy or pareve lunches from home. On Thursdays and Fridays, families have the option of

purchasing a kosher dairy lunch provided by Sholom Home East. Cost for each meal is \$6.00. Please see enclosed form for details and to place an order. Payment can be made by check or by credit card online. Go to ttsp.org, click on "About Us" and select "Make a Payment."


